Goals and Objectives

GOALS: BENEFIT AND PROVIDE FOR THE WELFARE OF ALL THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA THROUGH THE RESPONSIBLE DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT OF OUR STATE'S ABUNDANT MINERAL RESOURCES

OBJECTIVES:

1. Assist, promote and protect the interests of the Mining, Oil and Gas, and Geothermal industries.
 - a) To serve as a liaison between the mineral industry and various state and federal governmental agencies, interest groups and the general public.
 - b) Advocate legislation which will minimize the effects of restrictive regulations which impose an unnecessary burden on the industry.
 - c) Assist in the discovery and development of the state's mineral resources through the principles of private enterprise.
 - d) Assist the small mine operators in the acquisition of or access to custom milling facilities.
 - e) Develop and implement a dynamic, positive, and effective public relations and education program.
2. Provide for an equitable and balanced use of the public lands and for the wise use and management of the state's mineral resources.
 - a) Serve on State's Environmental Commission.
 - b) Maintain a database on active mines in Nevada (Mine Registry) to monitor production, economics, and the state of the industry.
 - c) Actively participate in land use study groups and committees.
 - d) Review and evaluate all available data to determine the best use of the land.
 - e) Fairly and equitably enforce the state's oil and gas and geothermal regulations.
